I should like to inform to the examiner, Mr Andy Mead, of the detail within the proposal for several large developments proposed within the Wilshamstead Parish referred to in my previous letter and put forward in the Bedford Borough Local Plan 2040 currently out for review.

If allowed these developments would treble the size of the village and, at an Open Meeting held yesterday all but 1 of the 125 people who attended, were objecting to the proposal in view of the minimal infrastructure and lack of additional facilities provided for in the Plan and the threat to the current rural nature of our village described in the Wilshamstead Neighbourhood Plan.

I attach an overlay onto our Policies Map of the proposed locations and sizes plus descriptions taken from the proposed Local Plan of the areas for development.
