

### **Highways Speed Data - Good and bad**

The Parish Council is now extracting the data from the Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) which have been in situ since October. The data shows a large majority of vehicles keeping to the speed limit but it also shows some worrying data particularly with regard to the highest speed recorded.

#### >>> Bedford Road

1965 vehicles per day 80% within the speed limit 16% just over the limit 4% prosecutable

### Highest speed recorded 97mph!!!

Clearly this is a major accident waiting to happen?

#### >>> Luton Road

793 vehicles per day 94.4% within the speed limit 3.7% just over the limit 1.9% prosecutable

### Highest speed recorded 67mph

#### >>> Cotton End Road

(travelling from East to West)

500 vehicles per day

81.9% within the speed limit

14.6% just over the limit

4% prosecutable

Highest speed recorded 69mph

#### >>> Cotton End Road/Chapel Lane

(travelling from West to East)

1022 vehicles per day

88.5% within the speed limit

9.2% just over the limit

2.3% prosecutable

#### Highest speed recorded 82mph!!!

This data will be passed to the Police and will be used to justify Police Speed Checks in the future.

Based upon the above, 137 drivers per day would have been caught speeding and prosecuted over the period the speed signs have been in operation.





We are still looking for volunteers to collect and report this data on a regular basis. If you can help please contact the Parish Clerk as shown below.

### Neighbourhood Plan Referendum Result

It was great to see the village turnout on 24th November at the Referendum for the Wilshamstead Neighbourhood Plan.

Thank you to those who took the time to attend and engage in any part of the consultation process along the way. The confirmed results of the vote were:

In favour: **395** Against: **45** 

**Unmarked papers: 2** 

Total number of attendees: **443** which equals 21.8% of eligible voters.

This is a high level of turnout for a Neighbourhood Plan - very pleasing indeed to see.

### **Financial Items Update**

At the last Parish Council meeting there was approval for a grant to be made to the Scout Group to enable them to purchase a pizza oven, with a donation of £159.99 being agreed.

The Parish Council had also sought financial support from the Borough Councillor Ward Fund to assist with plans to expand the seating provision in the play area at Whitworth Way. We are pleased to have recently been notified of £1,500 being awarded towards this work.

The Parish Council is now working hard on producing the budget workings for 2023/24 which will be used to set the Parish Precept for the next financial year.

### **Cotton End Road Average Speed Cameras Latest**

A site meeting took place between Parish Councillors and the responsible Borough Engineer on 1st December to look at the exact locations possible for Average Speed Cameras in Cotton End Road. Frustratingly a number of site locations proposed are not possible due to the location of utilities, overhead cables, the ownership of the land, parked cars obscuring the collection of number plate information or overhanging trees or vegetation.

We are left with four possible locations at the Western end (Dines Close or around the first entrance to Whitworth Way and one just after the long straight heading towards Littleworth (all others having been ruled out for the above technical reasons).

The Parish Council spent a lot of time at the December Council meeting discussing next steps and are supportive that one of the VAS units from Cotton End Road be relocated to Littleworth so those residents receive some coverage from the VAS unit now that it has proven impossible to locate an ASC in that area.

At the time of writing the Parish Council is waiting to be advised which of the alternative locations would be possible based upon the records of utilities that are buried in the area, as feedback to the searches takes some time. The Parish Council continues to pursue securing the average speed cameras as soon as possible to ensure the need of Wilstead is prioritised over the 80 different locations in the Borough that have been identified and the Police have been very helpful in backing our case.

### **The Next Parish Council Meeting**

This will be held on **Monday 9th January** at 7.00pm at the Jubilee Centre in Jubilee Way next to the Football/Sports Field. There will be the opportunity for the public to voice any concerns they may have over any issue, including the location of Average Speed Cameras.

### **Footpath Group**

### **Meetings**

The next meeting of the Footpath Group will be on Saturday 11th February at 10.00am in the Village Hall (small hall).

Members of the Group will be reporting on the paths they have been given and any other issues. These paths are changed every few months so in time members of the group get to report on all the paths in the Parish.

#### Work

In the New Year the Group will be tackling some minor work on the paths including cutting back overgrowth and undergrowth, replacing/reinstalling the odd way mark post and replacing faded way mark discs.

Currently all of the paths around the Village appear to be passable. The recent snow and any subsequent rain may have made sections of the paths a bit trickier to go along but all are walkable.

However if you do notice a problem on any of the Public Footpaths or Public Bridleways please contact the number below and the Group will look to get the problem resolved.

#### Walks

The approximately 5 mile end of November walk was through the fields, woods and parkland around Woburn. The weather was good and the views over the surrounding countryside great. There were some unusual Bedfordshire animals seen on the walk.



The optional post walk refreshments were at the Black Horse in Woburn.

Hopefully the New Year's Walk along the footpaths and bridleways around the Village were dry.







